

Management of ContractorsContractor Pre-qualification Guidance



Anglian Water has set minimum Health & Safety pre-qualification standards for its contractors and suppliers carrying out work for or supplying goods to Anglian Water.

The level and nature of the pre-qualification required [set out in the table below] is dependent on the level of health & Safety risk assigned to the work to be undertaken or the goods supplied. A guide to Anglian Water's risk rating approach is provided in Appendix A of this document.

Wherever possible, contractors shall have the appropriate level of pre-qualification prior to the contract award. Where this is not possible, the contractor shall agree to ensure that participation in an appropriate scheme [or alternative Industry specialist accreditation] within agreed timescales. Where further guidance is required, please contact the Anglian Water Commercial Procurement team.

SSIP – **Safety Scheme in Procurement** - A common threshold of accepted H&S pre-qualifications such as CHAS, Safe Contractor, Constructionline etc.

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Appendix A - Contractor Risk Rating

The below tables provide a guide to Anglian Water's approach to assigning a level of risk for goods and services provided to Anglian Water.
